Alexandra Amrhein is an Assistant United States Attorney in the District of Massachusetts, where she works in the office's Asset Recovery Unit ("ARU"). ARU implements mission-critical DOJ goals, including disrupting criminal enterprises, ensuring that crime does not pay, and recovering funds for victims of crime. While at the USAO, AUSA Amrhein has tried multiple cases to verdict and has argued appeals in front of the First Circuit. Prior working for the government, AUSA Amrhein spent 10 years in private practice at a large international law firm, where she was a member of the Intellectual Property Litigation Group, focusing on high-stakes patent litigation in the semiconductor and pharmaceutical sectors.
