

District Attorney Kevin Steele

Kevin Steele was sworn in as District Attorney in January 2016. Since then, he and his team of prosecutors, detectives and staff have worked with Montgomery County's 50 police departments and other local, state and federal partners to investigate crime and hold criminals accountable.

Steele joined the DA's Office in 1995 and has prosecuted hundreds of cases including a number of domestic/relationship violence murders in the last few years. He also recently prosecuted cases involving the death of firefighter, attempted murder of a police officer and a stranger/gunpoint rape case that was solved using genetic genealogy.

Throughout his career, Steele has been committed to community service, serving as a board member of Mission Kids Child Advocacy Center and Montgomery County Child Advocacy Project, as Board Vice President of local fire company and in multiple alumni roles at Penn State University, including serving as President of the Penn State Alumni Association.

In 2019, Steele was honored with the Pennsylvania Governor's "Pathfinder Award" for his commitment to victims and was inducted into the prestigious American College of Trial Lawyers.
